- Provide educational forums and documentary screenings with over 400 community leaders in attendance in the past four screenings
- Lead Agency for Global Youth Service Day 2016—over 1,500 youth throughout Berks County participated in youth lead services projects
- Development of over 40 Youth-Led Service Learning Projects
- Olivet's Thanksgiving Event—provide Thanksgiving meals and activities for children and their families
- Girls On The Run—provide full scholarships to 150 to participate in the program
